

GETTING TO KNOW

Lake Cumberland

Originally planned from the 1920's and enacted by Congress in the 1930's, with ground breaking in the early 1940's, the Wolf Creek Project began construction of Lake Cumberland under the supervision of the US Army Corps of Engineers. Early construction of Wolf Creek Dam to impound the Cumberland River was halted by World War II. Following the war, work resumed and the dam was closed in 1950, beginning what was originally named Wolf Creek Reservoir. The lake was completed for full use in August 1952. The name "Wolf Creek" comes from the original planned location for the dam, several miles upstream near the confluence of Wolf Creek with the Cumberland River. Though the location changed, the name remained. The body of water was officially renamed "Lake Cumberland" in 1954. The lake was formed by damming a large section of the Cumberland River.

Wolf Creek Dam is the 22nd largest dam in the United States. Operation of the lake is for the primary purposes of flood control and production of hydro-electric power. The Wolf Creek Dam, powerhouse, and lake are operated and supervised by the Corps of Engineers.

Lake Cumberland is 101 miles long and is one of the largest man-made lakes in the Nation. Each year millions of visitors travel from all over the United States to come to the Lake Cumberland area to enjoy the rugged beauty of its 63,000 surface acres and 1,255 miles of wooded shoreline. Whether you are renting a houseboat, bringing your own boat, fishing, swimming, or skiing, you'll discover the tranquility Lake Cumberland offers.

HISTORY



Russell County, Kentucky was named for Col. William Russell. Russell, a military leader and statesman, participated in the American Revolution, various Indian wars, and the War of 1812, as well as holding legislative office in both Virginia and Kentucky.

Russell County was the 81st county in Kentucky and was created in 1825 from sections of Adair, Cumberland and Wayne counties.

It is a small county, situated in the south middle section of the state and lies on both sides of the Cumberland River, is bounded north and northeast by Casey; east by Pulaski; southeast by Wayne; south by Clinton; and west and northwest

by Cumberland and Adair counties. The beautiful level bottom land on the Cumberland is very fertile, but the surface of the county generally is hilly and broken. Good streams of water abound and two woolen factories were established before 1847 and many other factories then were advantageously established.

The town of Creelsboro, the oldest settlement in the area, was thriving some 16 years before Russell County was formed. It was named for Elijah Creel, an early settler. At one time Creelsboro was the busiest river port on the Cumberland River between Nashville, Tennessee and Burnside, Kentucky. Kentucky steamboats that supplied most of the transportation of goods for a five county area put into port at Creelsboro, where there was a bank, a school, three stores and a building that provided lodging for steamboat passengers. Today, several original buildings stand vacant, devoid of the hustle and bustle of steamboat days.

The "Rock House Bottom" is a Natural Bridge Arch of solid limestone 300 million years old carved by nature. This huge natural rock formation has a roof 60 feet high and about 120 feet wide.

Hunters of the "Long Hunters" fame discovered this arch in 1770. Used by Indians and early settlers as a shelter against the elements, Native Americans are said to have buried their dead on top of the natural bridge. Today the "Rock House" is a center for camp meetings and social events. Visitors find the "Rock House" a breathtaking natural wonder.
