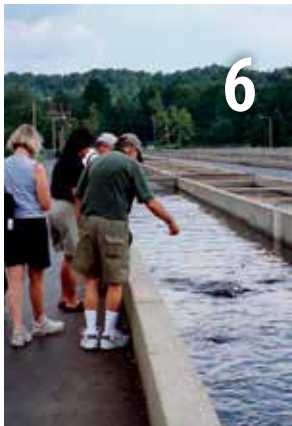

The visitor center includes a Civil War reference library, a gift shop and a free 20-minute video on the history of the Battle of Mill Springs. Regular events include a weekend full of history and fun for the entire family held the fourth weekend in June. Learn about the Battle of Mill Springs, visit a Civil War camp and learn how to shoot a cannon. In the fall, participate in a Civil War camp ghost walk.

A self-guided, **INTERPRETIVE WALKING TOUR** of downtown Somerset leads you through part of its rich history.
